Profile of the College:

D.R.M. Science College, formerly known as DRM college is the mother of all the constituent schools and colleges of Bapuji Educational Association. Previously it was a Govt. Intermediate college started in 1947 and was run by the Govt. of Mysore. Bapuji Educational Association took over this college in 1958 (Perhaps first of its kind) and converted it into First Grade Arts, Commerce and Science College. Being the only college at that time in and around Davangere, it catered to the needs of the aspirants of higher education - both rural and urban. It is named after the donor Sri Dharmarathnakara Rajanahalli Maddurayappa (DRM), Davangere.

The college, owing to its increasing strength, was bifurcated into D.R.M. Science College and A.R.G. College of Arts and Commerce in 1973. The college which had the permanent affiliation to Kuvempu University, is now affiliated to Davangere University after its commencement four years ago. This is an aided college, and is recognised by the U.G.C. with 2f, 12B and is getting U.G.C. grants.

The Govt. of Karnataka took a decision to separate P.U. Classes from composite degree colleges and accordingly the college was further bifurcated into D.R.M. P.U. Science College and D.R.M. Science College in 2001.

The Fourth block is our College library -a store house of knowledge. It also includes Electronics, Computer Science and Microbiology departments & labs. Micro Biology lab has been converted into Language lab.

The College has a separate Vehicle stand for Staff and Students. It has a small canteen of its own.

The college has grown by leaps and bounds ever since its origin. The very fact that the college has been bifurcated twice, speaks volume for its growth and development. It has over 31800 books in addition to a good number of National and Inter-National Magazines and Science Journals, Daily News Papers of different languages are provided to the students.

The library and the college office have been computerized. This faciliates the smooth functioning of both office & library work.

N.C.C. and N.S.S.:

The college has a N.C.C wing monitored by an able N.C.C. Officer. The college has a N.S.S. Unit too. The N.S.S. activities are regularly carried out under the guidance of the committed N.S.S. Officer. The life line of N.S.S. provides blood in times of emergency to the needy.
